Re: Clinton Township Administrative Consent Order, AFO-SW10-007
Revision to Fourth Amended Administration Consent Order

The DNRE has received and reviewed Clinton Township's letter January 14, 2011, requesting extensions to several dates listed in the Compliance Program Section of the Fourth Amended Administration Consent Order, AFO-SW10-007. The DNRE grants the following revisions to paragraphs 23b, 23c, and 24 through 27, as follows:

23b. On or before September 1, 2011, the Township shall submit to the Department for approval, a report with selected alternative that will complete the appropriate engineering and structural improvements to its sanitary sewerage system (Part 41 permits shall be obtained as appropriate), to meet all applicable state and federal laws pertaining to SSOs.

23c. On or before December 31, 2014, the Township shall complete construction of the approved alternative submitted under 23b.

24. On or before July 1, 2014, the Township shall submit to the Department for approval, a work plan for conducting a Sanitary Sewer System Project Performance Certification (PPC) Program to certify that the engineering and structural improvements the Township has implemented meet all applicable state and federal law pertaining to SSOs.

25. On or before January 1, 2015, the Township shall have initiated the Sanitary Sewer System PPC Program in accordance with the approved work plan. The Township shall notify the Department, in writing, of compliance with this requirement by January 15, 2015. The PPC program shall be conducted for a period of no less than one year.

26. On or before February 1, 2016, the Township shall submit to the Department for approval, the Sanitary Sewer System PPC Program report.

27. If the Township does not certify that the engineering and structural improvements the Township has implemented meet all applicable state and federal law pertaining to SSOs, then the Township shall submit an approvable Corrective Action program work plan to the Department on or before July 31, 2016.
