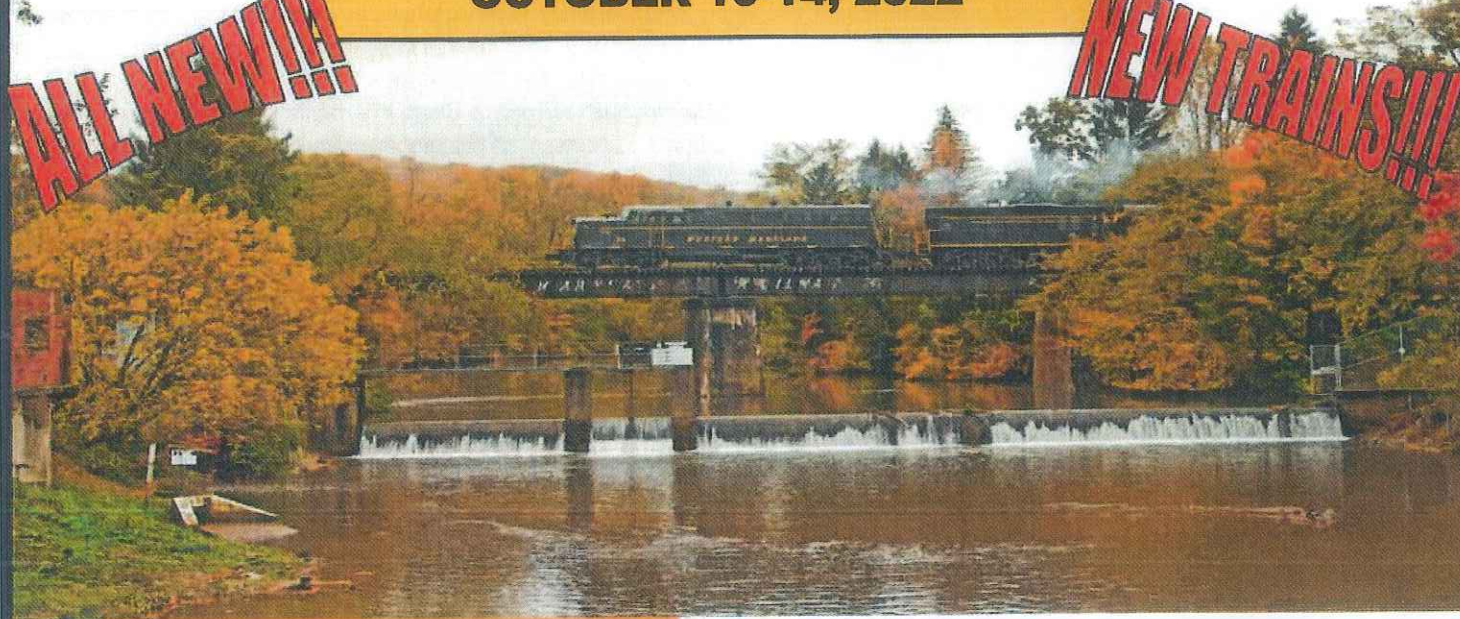

Sample Itinerary

Day 1: We all marvel at the spectacular colors of autumn. They paint a landscape with an amazing palette of yellow, orange, red and purple against a shrinking canvas of green. West Virginia is known throughout the country as having some of the best and most scenic fall colors. Vibrant hues transform the rolling hills, mountains and back roads into a masterpiece of nature. Travel to Elkins, WV for (2) nights. Dinner included at Graceland Mansion, a beautiful Victoria home.

Day 2: Begin the day with a visit to the West Virginia Railroad Museum dedicated to educating visitors and the community about West Virginia's railroad history. Lunch included. All aboard the New Tygart Flyer for a 4-hour, 46 mile rail excursion. This wilderness journey features mountain grades, a "S" curve tunnel, a high bridge and miles of unspoiled mountain views. Vintage diesel-powered locomotives climb along the cascading Shavers Fork of the Cheat River to the High Falls of Cheat. Enjoy the spectacular views while relaxing aboard comfortable climate controlled passenger coaches. Tonight join us at the Gandy Dance Dinner Theatre for a West Virginia Mountain style musical variety show.

Day 3: Our first stop is the Green Bank Observatory, the world's largest radio telescope. The Green Bank site was part of the National Radio Astronomy Observatory until 2016. Lunch included. Head south enjoying the mountain scenery to Cass, WV, home of the Cass Scenic Railroad. The "RIDE TO THE TOP" at Bald Knob is 22-mile round trip and 4.5 hours. Panoramas of the lofty Appalachian Mountains become more beautiful as the train climbs higher and higher. Passengers suddenly realize they are entering a completely different world, mainly because of the change in trees, flowers and atmosphere. By climbing the 2,390 feet from Cass to Bald Knob (4,842-feet) on Back Allegheny Mountain, passengers have made the equivalent to an 800 mile trip to Canada in climate because of the higher altitude. Dinner included to-night. Lodging (2) nights in Lewisburg, W.V.

Day 4: Take a guided tour the Beckley Exhibition Coal Mine aboard on underground "coal man tram". A veteran coal miner provides first hand accounts of the daily responsibilities and the very difficult work load of past and present day miners. After lunch arrive at America's Resort - The Greenbrier. As a National Historic landmark, the Greenbrier Resort's classic architecture, exquisite interior design, carefully sculpted landscape, impeccable service and outstanding amenities has hosted distinguished guests from around the world since 1778. Upon arrival take the famous Greenbrier Bunker Tour, a must-see behind-the-scenes guided tour. Carved deep into the mountainside beneath the resort is an emergency Cold War fallout shelter. Once a top secret U.S. government relocation facility for Congress, The Bunker is now open to relive a legendary piece of The Greenbrier history. After the tour, enjoy some leisure time at the famous Greenbrier for your own explorations.
