

Guidelines for Cart Placement

YES

Place your container as shown below. The automated truck's robotic arm must be able to reach out to the canister and not touch any obstacles.



FOR GRAVEL ROADS

Place carts off the lawn and onto the edge of the gravel road.
Do not block driveway.



FOR PAVED ROADS WITH NO CURB

Place carts off the pavement and onto the edge of the lawn.
Do not block driveway.



FOR PAVED ROADS WITH A CURB

Place carts on the pavement up next to, and touching, the curb.
Do not block driveway.

NO

Please DO NOT place your container behind any obstructions, such as cars, trees, posts, or in hard to reach areas - and never block a driveway.

Important Clinton Township Waste Program Improvements



Clinton Township residents will begin mandatory use of 96-gallon refuse containers starting in May..

The new heavy duty containers are gray
color with hinged lids and large wheels.

Please Read Carefully

Dear Clinton Township Resident,

In an effort to keep our Township neat and clean, residents will be receiving a gray 96-gallon refuse cart as part of the Township's refuse hauling contract with GFL Environmental USA Inc. (GFL). In May of 2016, delivery of the gray 96-gallon refuse carts will begin. Upon delivery, residents are required to start using the new container for trash removal. The carts are assigned to each individual property within Clinton Township and have a serial number that will be coded to each address upon delivery. Carts will be the property of Clinton Township and must remain at the property.

Please see reverse side for the correct placement of the new carts on your collection day. Thank you for helping us improve our solid waste program.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What can I put in the new trash cart? Regular household garbage.

2. Should I place garbage in plastic bags before placing it in the refuse cart? YES. Bags are required to eliminate odors, spills and rodents. Please keep lids closed at all times to help keep our community litter-free.

3. If my cart is full what do I do with the additional garbage bags? For the occasional bag or two, please place along side your cart, however a second cart will have to be purchased if you consistently cannot fit all garbage bags in your one cart.

4. How can I purchase a second refuse or recycling cart? Please call GFL at 844.464.3587. Cost per cart is \$75.00.

5. Are smaller carts available?

YES. If after the initial cart deployment is completed you find that a smaller cart would be more convenient, contact GFL at 844.464.3587 to request one.

The smaller, 65 gallon carts will be available within 60 days. Additionally, senior citizens or people with special needs can request door side services for an additional \$22/month.

6. Can I put yard waste into my refuse cart? NO. Yard waste will continue to be collected separately, in paper compost bags or 32-35 gallon cans with a 50 pound weight limit marked YARD WASTE.

6. Can I put "Bulky Waste" into my refuse cart? NO. Bulk waste, such as appliances and furniture, will continue to be collected separately.

7. How early can I put my refuse cart out for collection?

No earlier than 6:00 p.m. the night before your pick-up day or before 6:30 a.m. the morning of collection day.

8. Where should I place my refuse cart for collection?

Please place your trash cart in the street, close to the curb or next to your driveway approach. Please see the diagrams on the reverse side showing how carts should be set out for collection. If you live along a major thoroughfare where no parking is allowed in the street such as Groesbeck, 15 Mile Road, Little Mack, etc. then please DO NOT place your container in the street but place it on the edge of your property close to the curb.

9. What should I do with my old trash containers? You

could use them for additional yard waste containers or for storage. If you want them to be picked up as trash, please put a sign on them that clearly says: "Please take can as garbage"

10. Will I be billed for this new trash cart? NO. The Township owns the trash carts and there will not be a separate fee to the residents for the new cart.

11. What if I have a problem with my new cart? The new refuse & recycling carts have a ten year warranty. If you experience any issues please contact GFL at 844.464.3587 for assistance. Deficiencies with your new cart will result in the cart being replaced.
