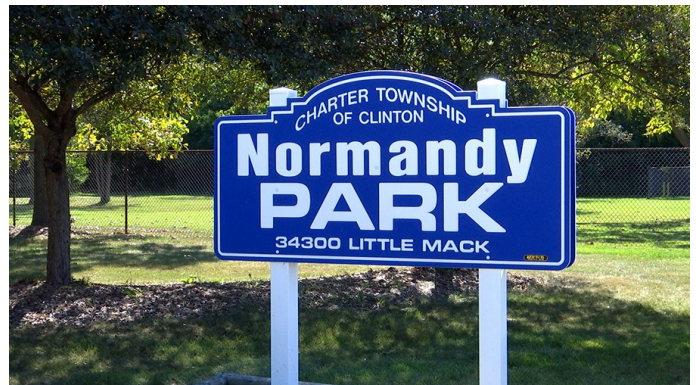
FAMILY SIGN-UP

We are seeking 15 families to join us to plant one of 15 trees. Due to COVID-19, we are changing things up to keep everyone safe and still get this work done.

Families can work together. Trees will be spaced far enough apart to allow for social distancing.

This event includes a short presentation about the importance of trees in our eco-system and training on how best to plant them. After planting, families will be able to hang a sign on the tree they plant.

The Clinton Township Dept. of Public Services will pre-dig the holes. Equipment is available to spread the roots, place the tree, fill soil, water and mulch. Please bring gloves, and a shovel or rake if you have them.



The tree planting will take place rain or shine unless the weather is severe.

A representative of the Conservation Committee will be available to sign forms for volunteer hours or scout badges.
